Re: Joint hearing titled "Mandates, Meddling, and Mismanagement: The IRA's Threat to Energy and Medicine"

On Tuesday, May 20, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. ET in room HVC-210 of the U.S. Capitol Visitor Center, the Subcommittee on Economic Growth, Energy Policy, and Regulatory Affairs and the Subcommittee on Health Care and Financial Services will host a joint hearing titled "Mandates, Meddling, and Mismanagement: The IRA's Threat to Energy and Medicine."

I. BACKGROUND:

The Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) was signed into law by President Biden on August 16, 2022. Since that time, cost estimates for many of the IRA's energy provisions and tax credits have continued to increase from previous estimates at the time of passage. Medicare Part D premiums have skyrocketed and investment in innovative treatments and therapies has reduced.

II. HEARING PURPOSE:

This hearing will examine how policies within the IRA will impact the future of the energy and transportation sectors, health care innovation, the tax code, the federal budget, and the U.S. economy.
