Norbert S. Doyle is the Chief Procurement and Logistics Officer for the Veterans Health Administration (VHA), Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Headquarters, Washington, D.C., effective December 4, 2011. He is responsible for the VHA supply chain organization which includes acquisition and logistics. The 8 billion dollar Procurement and Logistics Program consists of contracting, materiel management, data management, and the medical/surgical standardization program. This involves developing the annual VHA Acquisition Plan that forms the basis for VHA's acquisition strategy, developing a comprehensive plan for the standardization of health care supplies and equipment, and developing improvements to the supply chain management within VHA. In addition, Mr. Doyle is the business owner of the Service-Oriented Architecture Research and Development (SOARD) project; a multi-year development initiative that will replace the VA's existing asset and inventory management systems with a single, web-based, integrated, enterprise-level system.
