Glaser has been a guest on a variety of television and radio programs, including Fox News, MSNBC, and National Public Radio, and has had his work published in the *New York Times*, the *Washington Post*, *USA Today*, the *Los Angeles Times*, and *Foreign Affairs*, among other outlets. He is the co-author, with Christopher A. Preble and A. Trevor Thrall, of *Fuel to the Fire: How Trump Made America's Broken Foreign Policy Even Worse (and How We Can Recover)* (Cato Institute, 2019).

Glaser earned a Master of Arts in International Security at the Schar School of Policy and Government at George Mason University and a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from the University of Massachusetts Amherst.
