**Re: Hearing on “Final Recommendations of the National Security Commission on Artificial Intelligence”**

On **Friday, March 12th at 11:00 a.m., in room 2118 of the Rayburn House Office Building and over Webex**, the Committee on Oversight and Reform Subcommittee on National Security and the Committee on Armed Services Subcommittee on Cyber, Innovative Technologies, and Information Systems will hold a hybrid hearing with members of the National Security Commission on Artificial Intelligence (NSCAI), which released its final report on March 1, 2021.<sup>1</sup>

**I. HEARING PURPOSE**

The hearing will examine the final recommendations of the NSCAI, including how the United States should develop and adopt artificial intelligence (AI) technologies to protect our competitive strategic advantage against state and non-state adversaries. The hearing will also consider how AI-enabled platforms can be implemented ethically and in accordance with the civil liberties of American citizens.
