Re: Hearing on "The U.S. and International Humanitarian Response to Russia's

Invasion of Ukraine"

On <u>Friday, June 10, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. ET</u>, the Subcommittee on National Security will hold a <u>remote hearing on the Zoom video platform</u> to examine the humanitarian impacts of Russia's illegal and unjustified invasion of Ukraine.

I. HEARING PURPOSE

The hearing will examine the humanitarian crisis resulting from Russia's unprovoked and unjustified war against Ukraine and the efforts of non-governmental and international aid organizations to deliver urgently needed assistance to support civilians affected by the conflict. The hearing will also consider the regional and global humanitarian implications of Russia's invasion of Ukraine, as well as how the United States and the international community can prepare to respond to its downstream effects on vulnerable populations in Ukraine and beyond.
