

Christopher Stokes is currently working as the Emergency Coordinator in Ukraine for Doctors Without Borders/ Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) Operational Center in Brussels (OCB). He has been in Ukraine since February, arriving initially to help prepare in the event of an escalation of fighting and then coordinating MSF's medical humanitarian response to the war.

Between 1993 and 2001 Mr. Stokes worked for MSF in multiple field assignments including serving as Head of Mission in Angola, Indonesia/East Timor, Kosovo, Rwanda, Afghanistan, and in Russia/Chechnya during the first Chechen War. Between 2001 and 2007 he was the Director of Operations for MSF OCB, from 2007 until 2008 he was MSF's International General Secretary, and from 2008-2018 he served as the General Director of MSF OCB. When not on field assignment he presently works for MSF as a Senior Analyst covering a range of contexts including Afghanistan, Yemen, and the Gaza Strip in addition to cross-cutting files.
