Re: Hearing on “Force Multipliers: Examining the Need for Additional Resources to Disrupt Transnational Crime at the Border and Beyond”

On **Wednesday March 8, 2023 at 10:00 AM EST in 2247 Rayburn House Office Building**, the Subcommittee on National Security, the Border, and Foreign Affairs will host a hearing on “Force Multipliers: Examining the Need for Additional Resources to Disrupt Transnational Crime at the Border and Beyond.”
