Dr. Jacob Olidort serves as Director of the Center for American Security at the America First Policy Institute (AFPI). Jacob is a historian of the Middle East with over a decade working on national security issues in the U.S. government and in different research institutions. Most recently he served as an advisor in the Office of former Vice President Mike Pence and as a foreign policy advisor for the late Senator Orrin Hatch (R-UT) and for Senator Josh Hawley (R-MO).
