#### I. BACKGROUND:

The Biden Administration oversaw the unlawful entry of more than 10 million illegal aliens into the United States. The Trump Administration is prioritizing border security and seeks to effectuate the removal of illegal aliens currently residing in the U.S.

This hearing will examine technologies that could empower U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement to track illegal aliens, more effectively enforce our immigration laws, and remove aliens unlawfully present in the United States.
