**Re: Hearing titled “Leveraging Technology to Strengthen Immigration Enforcement”**

On **Tuesday, March 4, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. ET in 2247 Rayburn House Office Building**, the Subcommittee on Cybersecurity, Information Technology, and Government Innovation will host a hearing titled “Leveraging Technology to Strengthen Immigration Enforcement.”

**I. BACKGROUND:**

The Biden Administration oversaw the unlawful entry of more than 10 million illegal aliens into the United States. The Trump Administration is prioritizing border security and seeks to effectuate the removal of illegal aliens currently residing in the U.S.
