

Dylan Hedtler-Gaudette is the Director of Government Affairs at the Project On Government Oversight (POGO), a nonpartisan independent watchdog organization. Dylan leads POGO's advocacy efforts and has worked on policy reform related to a wide range of good governance issues, including defense spending, foreign influence, government ethics, and federal court reform.
