In addition, PBS was awarded \$129 million since March 26, 2022, from CPB, a private, not for profit corporation that receives a federal appropriation - 90% for multi-year replacement and upgrade of the public television interconnection system and the National Program Service, and 10% for content development and engagement, digital development and distribution, regional digital content innovation centers, and local audience dashboards for PBS member stations.
