Re: Field hearing titled "Federal Foreclosure: Reducing the Federal Real Estate Portfolio"

On Tuesday, April 8, 2025, at 10:00 AM ET in the Wilbur J. Cohen Federal Building Auditorium, the Subcommittee on Delivering on Government Efficiency will host a field hearing titled "Federal Foreclosure: Reducing the Federal Real Estate Portfolio."

I. BACKGROUND:

The federal government, through the U.S. General Services Administration, administers an enormous portfolio of federal buildings, offices, and other real estate, much of which has been underutilized for years. American taxpayers pay billions of dollars annually for leases and upkeep for unused federal space, while the backlog of deferred maintenance on government-owned buildings continues to grow.
