Matthew D. Dickerson is Director of Budget Policy at the Economic Policy Innovation Center (EPIC).

Dickerson is recognized as an expert on fiscal policy issues, including the budget, appropriations, and entitlement reform. His articles have been featured in the *Wall Street Journal*, the *Miami Herald*, *National Review*, the *Sacramento Bee*, the *Washington Times*, the *Baltimore Sun*, *The Hill*, the *Washington Examiner*, and other outlets.

Prior to joining EPIC, Dickerson served as Senior Policy Advisor on the staff of the House Budget Committee, where he helped lead development of the fiscal year 2024 budget resolution.

He has a dozen years of experience on Capitol Hill, including as a senior staffer with the Republican Study Committee, the caucus of conservatives in the House of Representatives. Under four different RSC chairmen, Dickerson held senior level roles including Policy Director and Senior Policy Staff. Additionally, he served as Legislative Director and other policy positions for the late Congressman C.W. Bill Young (R-FL), a former Chairman of the powerful House Appropriations Committee.

During his tenure at the Heritage Foundation, Dickerson was Director of the Grover M. Hermann Center for the Federal Budget. In this capacity, he oversaw a team of budget analysts and economists researching diverse subjects such as spending, entitlements, budget process, tax, labor, pensions, and infrastructure issues. He has also been a Policy Manager at Americans for Prosperity, where he supervised a team of fellows and analysts covering a variety of federal and state policy issues.

Dickerson is a graduate of the College of William and Mary in Virginia and holds a Bachelor of Arts in Government and History.
