Re: Hearing titled “Combating Waste, Fraud, and Abuse in SNAP”

On **Thursday, June 25, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. ET in 2154 Rayburn House Office Building**, the Subcommittee on Delivering on Government Efficiency will host a hearing titled “Combating Waste, Fraud, and Abuse in SNAP.”

I. BACKGROUND:

The federal government currently spends more than \$100 billion annually on the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP). The U.S. Government Accountability Office (GAO) has reported for years about widespread fraud in the program. Its findings indicate that substantial cost savings in SNAP is achievable through enhanced program integrity measures that ensure funds are going to needy Americans and not fraudsters.

II. HEARING PURPOSE:

To examine the root causes of waste, fraud and abuse in SNAP, and determine next steps Congress and the Administration can take to best remediate them.
