Prior to joining the FTC in August 2013, Mr. Robbins served as the Managing Director / Chief Operating Officer of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), where he led the agency's administrative operations, including human resources / human capital management (CHCO), financial operations (CFO), information technology (CIO), administrative services (e.g. facilities and property management; fleet management; security; copy center; records management; etc.), office of the secretary, and major program oversight & management (e.g. universal service fund (USF), etc.). Prior to joining the FCC, Mr. Robbins served as the Associate Administrator for the Small Business Administration's (SBA) Office of Management and Administration; and as an Assistant Director, Attorney, and Senior Program Manager in the FTC's Bureau of Consumer Protection. In addition, prior to joining the FTC in 2004, Mr. Robbins spent more than fifteen years working in the private sector as an executive, senior manager, IT professional, and attorney. Mr. Robbins received his J.D. from Seton Hall University School of Law in 1995, and a B.S. in Computer Science from Rutgers University in 1986.
