

Jeffrey P. Michael, Ed.D. Associate Administrator for Research and Program Development at the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration

Dr. Michael is Associate Administrator for Research and Program Development at the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration with responsibility for the development of programs to increase seat belt use, decrease impaired driving, and improve the safety of motorcyclists, bicyclists, pedestrians and older drivers.

Previously he served as Director of the Impaired Driving and Occupant Protection Office, with responsibility for developing and promoting programs to reduce alcohol and drug-impaired driving and increase the use of safety belts and child safety seats.

During his tenure, Dr. Michael also served as Chief of the agency's Emergency Medical Services Division, where he supported the national EMS system by developing and maintaining consensus guidelines for educating emergency medical technicians and improving EMS operations. Dr. Michael has served in the Federal government for twenty-five years.

Dr. Michael received his Doctorate of Education from West Virginia University, and his Bachelor of Design & Industry from San Francisco State University.
