His staff oversees the procurement of over 50,000 vehicles annually at a savings of over 17% from dealer invoice and manages the day-to-day operations of more than 204,000 vehicles, all with an eye to empowering civilian and military agencies alike to meet their diverse missions with excellence.

Prior to his service as the Director of the Office of Motor Vehicle Management, Mr. Toth had the pleasure of serving as the Director of the Planning and Performance Division in the Federal Acquisition Service's Office of Strategic Business Planning and Process Improvement, as the Director of the Service Contract Division in the former Federal Supply Service's Office of Commercial Acquisition, and as the Chief of the Program Operations Branch in the Office of Transportation and Property Management.
