Re: Hearing on "Effects of Vacancies at the Merit Systems Protection Board"

On <u>Thursday</u>, February 28, 2019, at 10:00 a.m., in room 2154 of the Rayburn House <u>Office Building</u>, the Subcommittee on Government Operations will hold a hearing on the Merit Systems Protection Board (MSPB).

I. HEARING PURPOSE

The hearing will examine: (1) the effects on the mission of the MSPB caused by vacancies since January 2017; (2) the independence of MSPB since its sole member was appointed by President Trump to serve concurrently as General Counsel of the Office of Personnel Management; and (3) the continuing operations of MSPB if it is left with no Members at the expiration of the remaining member's extended term of office, in March 2019.
