**Re: Hearing on “Overseeing the Overseers: The Council of the Inspectors General @ 10 Years”**

On **Wednesday, September 18, 2019, at 11:00 a.m., in room 2154 of the Rayburn House Office Building**, the Subcommittee will hold a hearing to examine the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency (CIGIE) on the 10th anniversary of its creation.

**I. HEARING PURPOSE**

For the nation’s 74 inspectors general (IG), CIGIE examines and establishes IG best practices, assists agency heads and the President in finding qualified candidates for vacant IG positions, and conducts investigations into allegations of misconduct or wrongdoing by senior Office of Inspectors General employees, among other services. The hearing will examine needed reforms, including increasing transparency, building collaboration across the inspector general IG community, and helping fill IG vacancies with qualified candidates.
