NTEU National President Anthony (Tony) Reardon has served as National President of NTEU since August 2015.

As the union's top elected official, he serves as the spokesperson for the union representing NTEU with the media, Congress and agency leadership on issues of importance to union members and federal employees. He leads NTEU's efforts to achieve dignity and respect for all federal workers. In his more than 25 years with the union, he also served as National Executive Vice President, Chief Operating Executive and Director of Operations.

Reardon is committed to working with NTEU chapter leaders and members to construct a shared vision for NTEU's future, one that prepares the union to meet the challenges ahead. He believes strongly that federal employees deserve fair pay and a secure retirement and has fought to give them the tools and resources they need to do their jobs.

In 2016, President Obama appointed Reardon to the National Council on Federal Labor-Management Relations and the Federal Salary Council.
