



Geoffrey A. Cherrington

Geoff Cherrington is the Inspector General of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority where he directs independent audits and investigations of Metro's programs and operations. He was formerly the Assistant Inspector General for Investigations at the U.S. Department of State where he was responsible for overseeing worldwide investigations. He also served as the Deputy AIGI at the U.S. Department of Agriculture and then the AIGI at the General Services Administration. Mr. Cherrington also spent 13 years as a special agent and special agent in charge with the Defense Criminal Investigative Service, where he oversaw investigations in the United States, Africa, Europe, and the Middle East.

Mr. Cherrington began his law enforcement career in 1984 with the U.S. Army and in 1989 became a special agent with the Army's Criminal Investigation Command. During that time he served in Nürnberg, Germany, and was deployed to the Gulf War where he conducted investigations and undercover operations during Operation Desert Storm.

Mr. Cherrington is a 2014 Presidential Rank Award winner, is the 2013 Federal Criminal Investigator Association's Investigator of the year, and has been featured on national and international news programs to include NBC's Fleecing of America and Bloomberg Live. He has a bachelor of science in psychology and a master of science in criminal justice administration. He is also a graduate of the Federal Executive Institute's Leadership for a Democratic Society.
