Edmund began his Postal career in Springfield, IL, on August 14th, 1999, as a PTF City Letter Carrier. He graduated from the Associate Supervisor Program in May of 2006 and became a Supervisor, Customer Service in Springfield.

On July 4th, 2008, Edmund was promoted to the position of Postmaster at the Lincoln, IL post office. During his tenure there, Edmund has detailed as Manager, Customer Service, City Route Inspection Team Leader, and Officer in Charge in level 21, 22, and 24 offices in Central Illinois.

Before being elected as National President of the United Postmasters and Managers of America, Edmund served in various offices on the Illinois Chapter level, including Legislative Chairman, and four years as Chapter President. In addition, he served as National Legislative Chair and National Vice President 2015-2018 and National Executive Vice President 2019-2021.
