Ms. Alissa Czyz is a member of the Senior Executive Service and serves as a Director in the Defense Capabilities and Management team at the U.S. Government Accountability Office (GAO). Her portfolio of work supports congressional oversight of the Department of Defense and the Intelligence Community. She oversees reviews on the personnel security clearance process; artificial intelligence; space policy and operations; intelligence infrastructure management, support to operations, and human capital; military installation and housing management; and DOD's approach to business transformation, among other topics.

Ms. Czyz joined GAO over 20 years ago and has spent most of her career in the national security and defense area. From 2020-2022, Ms. Czyz managed the Federal Workforce and Organizational Performance Management portfolio in GAO's Strategic Issues team. She led reviews examining federal recruitment and retention, workforce planning, interagency collaboration, and evidenced-based policymaking.

Before joining GAO, Ms. Czyz worked at the National Institute of Mental Health and in the nonprofit sector. She holds a BA from Knox College and an MA from American University. She completed American University's Executive Leadership Program and Yale University School of Management's Women's Leadership Program.
