

Colonel Eric R. Swenson assumed command of the St. Paul District July 28, 2022, becoming the district's 67th commander and district engineer.

The St. Paul District employs around 700 professionals that work at more than 40 sites in five upper-Midwest states. The district serves the American public in the areas of navigation, flood risk management, environmental enhancement, water and wetlands regulation, recreation sites and disaster response.

Since February 2024, Colonel Swenson has served as USACE's Recovery Field Office Commander for the 2023 Hawai'i Wildfire Recovery Mission.

Colonel Swenson holds both a Doctor of Philosophy and Master of Science in Industrial Engineering and Operations Research from Penn State University; a Master of Arts in National Security and Strategic Studies from the Naval War College; a Master of Arts in Strategic Studies from the Army War College, and a Bachelor of Science in Systems Engineering from the United States Military Academy.
