Re: Hearing titled "Safeguarding Procurement: Examining Fraud Risk Management in the Department of Defense"

On Wednesday, June 4, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. ET in 2247 Rayburn House Office Building, the Subcommittee on Government Operations will host a hearing titled "Safeguarding Procurement: Examining Fraud Risk Management in the Department of Defense."

I. BACKGROUND:

The Department of Defense (DOD) is the largest contracting agency within the federal government—with contract obligations in fiscal year 2023 of \$431.4 billion. For fiscal years 2017 through 2024, DOD reported approximately \$10.8 billion in confirmed fraud though the full extent of fraud is unknown.

II. HEARING PURPOSE:

This hearing will examine the extent of contracting fraud within the DOD and the Department's fraud risk management efforts to prevent contracting fraud.
