## District Manager — Alaska District

Ron Haberman was named Alaska District Manager effective March 3, 2012. He had been acting in the position since January 2012.

Ron began his postal career as a letter carrier in Austin, TX. He served in various management positions in Austin and transferred to Anchorage, Alaska in 1996. He held numerous management positions in Anchorage including Manager, Customer Service Operations and Manager, Operations Programs Support, before being selected as Senior Plant Manager in 2004, a position he held until taking over as District Manager.



Ron heads the Alaska District with over 1,567 employees and over 295 facilities. The District spans 586 million sq. miles or about 1.5 million sq. kilometers of the Alaska Wilderness, with an annual budget of \$165 million. Last year, 87.5 million pounds of bypass mail, for the calendar year alone, were processed and delivered to support the Alaskan Bush Community. The modes of transporting the mail have been diverse due to the weather and the terrain of Alaska. Carriers, planes, boats, hovercraft, helicopters and snowmobiles are some of the examples the District uses to transport mail to the customers on time.

Ron received the Western Area Vice President's Award in 2007 and has a Bachelor of Arts degree from Strayer University.

Ron has lived in Alaska for almost 18 years and enjoys his life with his wife, family and the Great Outdoors.
