Captain Hamby is currently assigned as the assistant commander of the Narcotic Enforcement Division for the Prince George's County Police Department. In this position, Captain Hamby is responsible for the day-to-day operations of sixty-five full time narcotic investigators. The Narcotic Enforcement Division investigates major narcotic conspiracies, street level narcotics, interdiction of smuggled narcotics, asset investigations, and also includes detectives assigned to four federal task force groups. The Narcotic Enforcement Division works in partnership with local, state and federal law enforcement partners to investigate, interdict and curtail drug trafficking impacting Prince George's County.

Captain Hamby has gained extensive experience in narcotic investigations throughout his law enforcement career. As a detective assigned to the Narcotic Enforcement Division, he investigated street level narcotic distribution, major narcotic conspiracies and drug trafficking organizations responsible for smuggling hundreds of kilograms of controlled dangerous substances into Prince George's County. Captain Hamby also supervised street level and major narcotic investigation squads prior to his promotion to Captain.

Captain Hamby has 27 years of law enforcement experience including nearly twenty years with the Prince George's County Police Department and seven years with the US Capitol Police Department.
