**Peter Warren Singer** is Strategist at New America and an editor at *Popular Science* magazine. He has been named by the Smithsonian as one of the nation's 100 leading innovators, by Defense News as one of the 100 most influential people in defense issues, by Foreign Policy to their Top 100 Global Thinkers List, and by Onalytica market research as one of the ten most influential voices in the world on cybersecurity. Peter's award winning books include *Corporate Warriors: The Rise of the Privatized Military Industry*, *Children at War*, *Wired for War: The Robotics Revolution and Conflict in the 21st Century*; and *Cybersecurity and Cyberwar: What Everyone Needs to Know*. His latest is *Ghost Fleet: A Novel of the Next World War*, a technothriller crossed with nonfiction research, which has been endorsed by people who range from the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs to the co-inventor of the Internet to the writer of HBO *Game of Thrones*. He is also the co-host of CSM Passcode's Cybersecurity podcast. Singer received his Ph.D. in Government from Harvard and a BA from the Wilson School of Public and International Affairs at Princeton.
