Re: Hearing on "Inflation: A Preventable Crisis"

On Thursday, March 9, 2023, at 2:00 p.m. E.T., in room 2247 of the Rayburn House Office Building, the Subcommittee on Health Care and Financial Services of the Oversight and Accountability will host a hearing on "Inflation: A Preventable Crisis."

I. BACKGROUND:

Over the past two years, inflation has reached 40-year highs, raising prices of groceries, gas, housing, and more. The Consumer Price Index for all goods increased 6.4 percent for the 12-month period ending in January 2023, on top of a 7.5 percent increase for the 12-month period ending January 2022.

II. HEARING PURPOSE:

The hearing will examine the causes of the recent inflationary crisis, impacts of the crisis on Americans, and policies to prevent future inflationary crises.
