Re: Joint Subcommittee hearing titled "Oversight of the Internal Revenue Service"

On Tuesday, October 24, 2023, at 2:00 PM ET, in room 2154 Rayburn House Office Building, the Subcommittee on Health Care and Financial Services and the Subcommittee on Government Operations and the Federal Workforce will host a joint hearing titled "Oversight of the Internal Revenue Service."

### I. BACKGROUND:
