Indivar Dutta-Gupta is a researcher, analyst, and policy influencer on U.S. economic policy. He is currently a Doris Duke Distinguished Visiting Fellow at Georgetown University's McCourt School of Public Policy, Tax Fellow at the Roosevelt Institute, Distinguished Visiting Fellow at the National Academy of Social Insurance, Advisor at Community Change, and CEO and Founder of Blue Lotus Strategies. He was recently president and executive director of the Center for Law and Social Policy and previously helped lead and grow the Georgetown Center on Poverty and Inequality. He frequently advises elected officials and their staff on economic policy, testifies before Congress, and speaks to the media.

His earlier work includes senior roles at the U.S. House of Representatives Ways and Means Committee, the Center on Budget and Policy Priorities, and Freedman Consulting.

Indivar is a Harry S. Truman Scholar, an honors graduate of the University of Chicago, and a former Bill Emerson National Hunger Fellow.
