Shaun Harper is University Professor and Provost Professor of Public Policy, Business, and Education at the University of Southern California, where he holds the Clifford and Betty Allen Chair in Urban Leadership. He also is the USC Race and Equity Center's founder and chief research scientist, a USC Schaeffer Institute for Public Policy & Government Service senior scholar, and a National Education Policy Center fellow. Dr. Harper was inducted into the National Academy of Education in 2021. His 13 books include Let's Talk About DEI: Productive Disagreements About America's Most Polarizing Topics (Teachers College Press, 2025) and The Big Lie About Race in America's Schools (Harvard Education Press, 2024). He also is author of over 100 academic papers, plus more than 125 essays and editorials published by the Washington Post, TIME, Forbes, Los Angeles Times, Rolling Stone, CNN.com, and numerous other media outlets. Professor Harper has done high-quality DEI work with more than 400 corporations, educational institutions, nonprofit and government agencies, and other organizations – the United States Air Force, Nike, Google, Microsoft, NBCUniversal, Amazon Music, Anheuser-Busch, T-Mobile, New York City Department of Education, Princeton University, Major League Baseball, and the National Football League, to name a few. Two U.S. Presidents and a California Governor have appointed him to meaningful public service roles.
