### Interim Chief Executive Officer MNsure

Scott Leitz was named Interim CEO by the Board of Directors on December 18. He brings 16 years of experience in the health care and public health sectors to the role.

Mr. Leitz comes to this role from the Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS) where he was an assistant commissioner responsible for overseeing and managing the state's Medicaid program. While there, he spearheaded the reform of the state's managed care and procurement processes; implemented accountable payment and health care delivery models in Medicaid; and implemented the Affordable Care Act.

Prior to this position, he was director of public policy for Children's Hospitals and Clinics of Minnesota. Mr. Leitz has also held several positions at the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH), including serving as Assistant Commissioner where he oversaw the development, passage, and implementation of Minnesota's landmark 2008 health reform act. At MDH, he also served as health policy division director, health economics program director, federal relations coordinator and research economist.

Mr. Leitz holds a bachelor's degree in economics and mathematics from the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire and earned a master's in public affairs from the University of Minnesota's Humphrey Institute of Public Affairs.
