Kerry E. Doyle earned a Bachelor of Arts in 1988 from The George Washington University, and a Juris Doctorate *cum laude* in 1993 from the American University, Washington College of Law.

From September to December 2024 she served as Deputy General Counsel, Office of General Counsel (OGC), Department of Homeland Security (DHS) overseeing the overall immigration portfolio and the Immigration Division at OGC. From February to May 2024, Ms. Doyle was detailed to OGC as Acting Deputy General Counsel and oversaw the Regulations, Intelligence, and Operations and Enforcement Law Divisions of OGC. Prior to OGC, from 2021 to August 2024, Ms. Doyle was the Principal Legal Advisor (General Counsel) of the Office of the Principal Legal Advisor, Immigration and Customs Enforcement, DHS. From 2001 to 2021, she was managing partner with Graves and Doyle, Attorneys at Law. From 1998 to 2001, Ms. Doyle was the managing attorney with the International Institute of Boston (now International Institute of New England) legal department in Boston, MA and from 1995 to 1998 she was the managing attorney of the legal department with Church World Service in Miami, FL. From 1993 to 1994 she was an attorney with Legal Assistance for Vietnamese Asylum Seekers in Hong Kong.

In addition to this work, she was appointed to two three-year terms as a voluntary hearing officer by the Massachusetts Board of Bar Overseers to preside over cases related to attorney disciplinary matters from 2016 through 2021.
