JOSEPH M. HUMIRE is the Executive Director at the Center for a Secure Free Society (SFS) and a national security expert analyzing transnational and transregional threats in the Western Hemisphere. Mr. Humire provides regular briefings on counterterrorism and countertransnational organized crime, as well as analysis on the authoritarian influence of China, Russia, and Iran in Latin America and the Caribbean, to various entities within the U.S. Department of Defense and intelligence community, as well as prominent think-tanks and universities worldwide. He testifies frequently before the U.S. Congress on national security issues and has also testified before the European and Canadian Parliament. Mr. Humire has served as an expert witness to several important international terrorism trials in North and South America. He is a regular national security commentator and contributor for a variety of English and Spanish language media, namely Fox News, Newsmax, OAN, Univision, Telemundo, CNN en Español, and has a regular weekly segment on the nationally syndicated radio show CBS Eye on the World with John Batchelor. He is the co-author of Iran's Strategic Penetration of Latin America, published in 2014 by Lexington Books, and is currently working on his next book China's Strategic Penetration of Latin America, due to be published in November 2025. More recently, he wrote the foreword for Confronting the Evolving Global Security Landscape, authored by his late mentor Dr. Max G. Manwaring, and published by Praeger Security International. Mr. Humire served in the U.S. Marine Corps with combat tours in Iraq and a multinational training exercise, UNITAS, in Latin America and the Caribbean, and was awarded an Order of Defense Merit Medal from the Colombian Armed Forces. After leaving the military, he attended George Mason University where he studied Economics and began building SFS's research team as the Director of Institute Relations at the Atlas Economic Research Foundation and was formerly a visiting fellow at The Heritage Foundation's Allison Center for National Security. Mr. Humire's unique blend of military experience, economics education, and expertise in asymmetric warfare offers a realist perspective to U.S. foreign policy and national security grounded in America First values and principles.
