Mr. Willemssen is the Managing Director of Information Technology Issues at the U.S. Government Accountability Office. In this position, he has overall responsibility for GAO's evaluations of information technology across the federal government. Specific responsibilities include government-wide and agency-specific assessments of computer security and critical infrastructure protection; electronic government; information collection, use, and dissemination; privacy; system and software development and acquisition; system operation and maintenance; enterprise architectures; technology investment management; and telecommunications.
