On January 20, 2019, Michael A. Bolton assumed the responsibilities of Inspector General for the United States Capitol Police (USCP). Selected by the Capitol Police Board, Mr. Bolton is the third individual to serve the Department in this capacity. Mr. Bolton was the Acting Inspector General from March 2018 to January 2019 and served as Assistant Inspector General for Investigations (AIGI) since August 2006. As the USCP's first AIGI, Mr. Bolton played an active role in establishing the office; developing policies, procedures, and memorandums of understanding with the USCP Office of Professional Responsibility and the Capitol Police Board. He provided leadership in promoting economy and effectiveness in USCP programs and operations as well as served as an independent and trusted contributor concerning the prevention of fraud, waste, and abuse.
