Inspector General

Brianna Schletz was appointed unanimously by the Commissioners of the U.S. Election Assistance Commission (EAC) and began serving as the Inspector General in November 2021. After her appointment, Ms. Schletz promptly issued an updated strategic plan for the Office of the Inspector General (OIG), addressed outstanding peer review recommendations, updated OIG policies, and issued mandatory and discretionary oversight products. Ms. Schletz has grown the office from one to five and pivoted from conducting audits only through contracts to also conducting work with internal staff.

Ms. Schletz is also involved in the Inspector General and auditing community. She is a participating member on several Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency committees and has served on the Comptroller General's Advisory Council on Government Auditing Standards (or Yellow Book Advisory Council) since April 2022.

Prior to assuming the role of Inspector General at the EAC, Ms. Schletz spent 8 years at the U.S. Agency for International Development Office of Inspector General (USAID OIG) where she served as a director and established a new strategic division within the Immediate Office. During her time at USAID OIG, Ms. Schletz led a team of program analysts responsible for congressionally mandated quarterly reporting and oversight planning on overseas contingency operations as well as conducting audits, evaluations and reporting on significant issues affecting agency operations. Prior to her time at USAID OIG, Ms. Schletz was a performance auditor at the Department of Health and Human Services OIG in New York and Washington, DC.

Ms. Schletz holds a Bachelor of Science in Accounting and a Master of Business Administration and has over 17 years of oversight experience. Her work has resulted in impactful changes to agency operations and programs covering a variety of sectors and has been recognized by the Inspector General community.
