6 (2) LIMITATION TO STUDENTS OF LEGAL VOT-
7 ING AGE.—The head of a school shall provide a stu-
8 dent with the form required under subsection (a)
9 only if the student will be of legal voting age at the
10 time of the next election for Federal office held in
11 the State in which the student will register to vote.

12 (3) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This subsection shall
13 apply with respect to elections for Federal office held
14 on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.

15 (b) PROVIDING CAPITOL-FLOWN FLAGS.—

16 (1) NOTIFICATION TO ARCHITECT OF THE CAP-
17 ITOL.—Not later than April 15 of every year (begin-
18 ning with 2024), the Secretary of Defense shall pro-
19 vide the Architect of the Capitol with a list of the
20 students attending high schools operated by the De-
21 partment of Defense Education Activity who are
22 graduating at the end of the academic year.

23 (2) PROVIDING FLAG.—The Architect of the
24 Capitol shall provide each student on the list pro-

- 1 vided under paragraph (1) with a Capitol-flown flag
- 2 at no cost to the student.
