AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4563

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Add at the end of title I the following new subtitle:

Subtitle H—Poll Worker 1 **Recruitment and Training** 2 3 SEC. 181. GRANTS TO STATES FOR POLL WORKER RECRUIT-4 MENT AND TRAINING. 5 (a) Grants by Election Assistance Commis-6 SION.— 7 IN GENERAL.—The Election Assistance 8 Commission (hereafter referred to as the "Commis-9 sion") shall, subject to the availability of appropria-10 tions provided to carry out this section, make a 11 grant to each eligible State for recruiting and train-12 ing individuals serving in AmeriCorps or AmeriCorps 13 Seniors under the National and Community Service 14 Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12501 et seg.) to serve as 15 poll workers on dates of elections for public office. 16 (2) Use of commission materials.—In car-17 rying out activities with a grant provided under this 18 section, the recipient of the grant shall use the man-19 ual prepared by the Commission on successful prac-20 tices for poll worker recruiting, training, and reten-

1	tion as an interactive training tool, and shall develop
2	training programs with the participation and input
3	of experts in adult learning.
4	(3) Access and cultural consider-
5	ATIONS.—The Commission shall ensure that the
6	manual described in paragraph (2) provides training
7	in methods that will enable poll workers to provide
8	access and delivery of services in a culturally com-
9	petent manner to all voters who use their services,
10	including those with limited English proficiency, di-
11	verse cultural and ethnic backgrounds, disabilities,
12	and regardless of gender, sexual orientation, or gen-
13	der identity. These methods must ensure that each
14	voter will have access to poll worker services that are
15	delivered in a manner that meets the unique needs
16	of the voter.
17	(b) REQUIREMENTS FOR ELIGIBILITY.—
18	(1) APPLICATION.—Each State that desires to
19	receive a payment under this section shall submit an
20	application for the payment to the Commission at
21	such time and in such manner and containing such
22	information as the Commission shall require.
23	(2) Contents of Application.—Each appli-
24	cation submitted under paragraph (1) shall—

1	(A) describe the activities for which assist-
2	ance under this section is sought;
3	(B) provide assurances that the funds pro-
4	vided under this section will be used to supple-
5	ment and not supplant other funds used to
6	carry out the activities;
7	(C) provide assurances that the State will
8	furnish the Commission with information on the
9	number of individuals who served as poll work-
10	ers after recruitment and training with the
11	funds provided under this section;
12	(D) provide assurances that the State will
13	dedicate poll worker recruitment efforts with re-
14	spect to diversity, including with respect to
15	race, ethnicity, and disability; and
16	(E) provide such additional information
17	and certifications as the Commission deter-
18	mines to be essential to ensure compliance with
19	the requirements of this section.
20	(c) Amount of Grant.—
21	(1) In general.—The amount of a grant
22	made to a State under this section shall be equal to
23	the product of—
24	(A) the aggregate amount made available
25	for grants to States under this section; and

1	(B) the voting age population percentage
2	for the State.
3	(2) Voting age population percentage de-
4	FINED.—In paragraph (1), the "voting age popu-
5	lation percentage" for a State is the quotient of—
6	(A) the voting age population of the State
7	(as determined on the basis of the most recent
8	information available from the Bureau of the
9	Census); and
10	(B) the total voting age population of all
11	States (as determined on the basis of the most
12	recent information available from the Bureau of
13	the Census).
14	(d) Reports to Congress.—
15	(1) Reports by recipients of grants.—Not
16	later than 6 months after the date on which the
17	final grant is made under this section, each recipient
18	of a grant shall submit a report to the Commission
19	on the activities conducted with the funds provided
20	by the grant.
21	(2) Reports by Commission.—Not later than
22	1 year after the date on which the final grant is
23	made under this section, the Commission shall sub-
24	mit a report to Congress on the grants made under
25	this section and the activities carried out by recipi-

1	ents with the grants, and shall include in the report
2	such recommendations as the Commission considers
3	appropriate.
4	(e) Funding.—
5	(1) Continuing availability of amount ap-
6	PROPRIATED.—Any amount appropriated to carry
7	out this section shall remain available without fiscal
8	year limitation until expended.
9	(2) Administrative expenses.—Of the
10	amount appropriated for any fiscal year to carry out
11	this section, not more than 3 percent shall be avail-
12	able for administrative expenses of the Commission.
13	SEC. 182. STATE DEFINED.
14	In this subtitle, the term "State" includes the Dis-
15	trict of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico,
16	Guam, American Samoa, the United States Virgin Is-
17	lands, and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana
18	Islands.
