

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 9360
OFFERED BY MR. STEIL OF WISCONSIN

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “Advisory Committee
3 on the Records of Congress Sunset Act”.

4 SEC. 2. MANAGEMENT AND PRESERVATION OF THE
5 RECORDS OF CONGRESS.

6 (a) SUNSET OF ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON THE
7 RECORDS OF CONGRESS.—Effective on the date that is
8 60 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, title
9 44 of the United States Code is amended—

10 (1) by striking chapter 27;

11 (2) by striking the table of sections relating to
12 chapter 27; and

13 (3) in the table of chapters, by striking the item
14 relating to chapter 27.

15 (b) REPORT.—Not later than February 1 of the year
16 beginning after the date of enactment of this Act, and an-
17 nually thereafter, the Director shall submit a report on

1 the management and preservation of the records of Con-
2 gress during the previous year to—

3 (1) the Archivist;

4 (2) the Secretary;

5 (3) the Clerk;

6 (4) the Committee on Homeland Security and
7 Governmental Affairs and the Committee on Rules
8 and Administration of the Senate; and

9 (5) the Committee on Oversight and Govern-
10 ment Reform and the Committee on House Adminis-
11 tration of the House of Representatives.

12 (c) REVIEW.—The Archivist, the Secretary, and the
13 Clerk shall meet to review the management and preserva-
14 tion of the records of Congress—

15 (1) not later than 60 days after the date on
16 which the Director submits a report under sub-
17 section (b); and

18 (2) not later than 180 days after the date on
19 which an individual begins to carry out the duties
20 and responsibilities of the Archivist, Secretary, or
21 Clerk.

22 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

23 (1) ARCHIVIST.—The term “Archivist” means
24 the Archivist of the United States, or any successor
25 thereto.

1 (2) CLERK.—The term “Clerk” means the
2 Clerk of the House of Representatives.

3 (3) DIRECTOR.—The term “Director” means
4 the Director of the Center for Legislative Archives
5 of the National Archives, or any successor thereto.

6 (4) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
7 the Secretary of the Senate.
