

OHIO SECRETARY OF STATE FRANK LAROSE BIOGRAPHY

Frank LaRose is serving his second term as Ohio's 51st Secretary of State, winning re-election in 2022 with more votes than anyone in the history of the office.

As Ohio's chief election officer, Frank has positioned our state as the gold standard for election administration, successfully overseeing record-setting statewide elections and creating a national model for election integrity.

Frank works tirelessly to make elections more transparent, secure, and accountable than ever before. He's the first Secretary of State to require mandatory audits for every statewide election, the first to create a full-time Public Integrity Division to investigate and prosecute fraud, the first to require cybersecurity standards for every county board of elections, and the first to establish an office dedicated to compiling election data for public analysis and accountability.

Frank is also responsible for incorporating all new businesses in Ohio, helping to lead Ohio's economic development success. During his administration, his office registered a record number of new ventures and led the first legislative effort in decades to modernize how businesses are created.

Frank previously served two terms as a state senator. He's a combat veteran of the United States Army Special Forces, where he earned a Green Beret and received numerous commendations, including the Bronze Star. He continues his military service now as a member of the U.S. Army Reserve, serving in a special operations unit.

Frank is a graduate of The Ohio State University. His most important role is at home, as a husband and father, alongside his wife Lauren and their three young daughters.
