

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE  
TO H.R. 1095  
OFFERED BY MR. ROGERS OF ALABAMA**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

**1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “TSA Loose Change  
3 Act”.

**4 SEC. 2. DISPOSITION OF UNCLAIMED MONEY RECOVERED  
5 AT AIRPORT SECURITY CHECKPOINTS.**

6 (a) DISPOSITION OF UNCLAIMED MONEY.—Section  
7 44945(a) of title 49, United States Code, is amended—

8 (1) by inserting “after the date of enactment of  
9 the TSA Loose Change Act,” after “title 31,”; and

10 (2) by striking “shall be retained by the Trans-  
11 portation Security Administration” and all that fol-  
12 lows through “this chapter” and inserting “shall be  
13 annually transferred, based on requests for pro-  
14 posals, without further appropriation, by the Assist-  
15 ant Secretary to nonprofit organizations that operate  
16 airport centers in multiple locations throughout the  
17 United States to provide places of rest and recuper-

1           ation for members of the Armed Forces and their  
2           families”.

3           (b) ANNUAL REPORT.—Section 515(b) of the De-  
4           partment of Homeland Security Appropriations Act, 2005  
5           (Public Law 108–334; 118 Stat. 1318; 49 U.S.C. 44945  
6           note) is amended—

7                   (1) by striking “the Committee on Transpor-  
8                   tation and Infrastructure of the House of Represent-  
9                   atives” and inserting “the Committee on Homeland  
10                  Security of the House of Representatives”; and

11                   (2) by striking “and specifically how the un-  
12                   claimed money is being used to provide civil aviation  
13                   security” and inserting “and the amount of un-  
14                   claimed money transferred to nonprofit organiza-  
15                   tions under section 44945(a) of title 49, United  
16                   States Code, and the dates of such transfers”.
