To amend title 49, United States Code, to direct the Assistant Secretary of Homeland Security (Transportation Security Administration) to transfer unclaimed money recovered at airport security checkpoints to nonprofit organizations that provide places of rest and recuperation at airports for members of the Armed Forces and their families, and for other purposes.

1 **SECTION 1. DISPOSITION OF UNCLAIMED MONEY RECOV-**
2 **ERED AT AIRPORT SECURITY CHECKPOINTS.**

3 (a) DISPOSITION OF UNCLAIMED MONEY.—Section
4 44945 of title 49, United States Code, is amended by
5 striking “shall be retained by the Transportation Security
6 Administration” and all that follows before the period at
7 the end and inserting “shall be annually transferred, with-
8 out further appropriation, by the Assistant Secretary to
9 nonprofit organizations that operate airport centers in
10 multiple locations throughout the United States to provide
11 a place of rest and recuperation for members of the Armed
12 Forces and their families”.

13 (b) ANNUAL REPORT.—Section 515(b) of the De-
14 partment of Homeland Security Appropriations Act, 2005
15 (Public Law 108–334; 118 Stat. 1318; 49 U.S.C. 44945
16 note) is amended—

17 (1) by striking “the Committee on Transpor-
18 tation and Infrastructure of the House of Represent-
19 atives” and inserting “the Committee on Homeland
20 Security of the House of Representatives”; and

21 (2) by striking “and specifically how the un-
22 claimed money is being used to provide civil aviation
23 security” and inserting “and the amount of un-
24 claimed money transferred to nonprofit organiza-

1 tions under section 44945 of title 49, United States
2 Code, and the dates of such transfers”.

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
