Mr. Chung has extensive experience in constructing and managing software systems. Inspired by 9/11, Mr. Chung created, Sentinel Visualizer, which helps people analyze large amounts of data to find hidden relationships among people, places and events. It is used by intelligence, defense and law enforcement communities worldwide.

Additionally, FMS Inc. provides Logistics Support System to coordinate humanitarian relief logistics for disasters around the world. Built for the Pan American Health Organization and sponsored by many UN Agencies, it's deployed in over 100 countries.

FMS Inc. also builds course management systems for Defense Acquisition University – which provides non-military training to all branches of the DoD.

Mr. Chung is a current member and past president of the Washington DC Chapter of the Entrepreneurs Organization. He serves on the Information Technology Policy Advisory Committee to the Fairfax County, Virginia Board of Supervisors to oversee county computer initiatives, as well as on a Business and Community Advisory Council to the Fairfax County School Superintendent
