Page 4, strike lines 14 through 18 and insert the following:

1 “(4) to the extent technically feasible, include in
2 the national integrated public alert and warning sys-
3 tem the capability to alert, warn, and provide the
4 equivalent amount of information to—
5 “(A) individuals with limited English pro-
6 ficiency skills;
7 “(B) individuals with disabilities, particu-
8 larly sensory disabilities; and
9 “(C) individuals with other access or func-
10 tional needs;

Page 6, line 11, after “tourists” insert “, individuals with limited English proficiency skills, and”.

Page 14, strike lines 18 and 19 and insert the following:

11 “(1) the recommendations of the most recent
12 Advisory Committee report under subsection (d)(8),
13 what recommendations under subsection (d)(8) the

1 Secretary has implemented to modernize the public
2 alert and warning system, and if any such rec-
3 ommendations identified under subsection (d)(8)
4 were not implemented, why the Secretary chose not
5 to implement such recommendations;
