

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 4007
OFFERED BY MS. JACKSON LEE OF TEXAS**

Page 17, after line 2, insert the following (and renumber the subsequent sections and revise the table of contents amendment accordingly):

1 **“SEC. 2107. SMALL COVERED CHEMICAL FACILITIES.**

2 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary may provide guid-
3 ance and, as appropriate, tools, methodologies, or com-
4 puter software, to assist small covered chemical facilities
5 in developing their physical security.

6 “(b) REPORT.—The Secretary shall submit to the
7 Committee on Homeland Security of the House of Rep-
8 resentatives and the Committee on Homeland Security
9 and Governmental Affairs of the Senate a report on best
10 practices that may assist small chemical facilities, as de-
11 fined by the Secretary, in development of physical security
12 best practices.

13 “(c) DEFINITION.—For purposes of this section, the
14 term ‘small covered chemical facility’ means a covered
15 chemical facility that has fewer than 350 employees em-

- 1 ployed at the covered chemical facility, and is not a branch
- 2 or subsidiary of another entity.”.
