

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3846
OFFERED BY MS. LORETTA SANCHEZ OF
CALIFORNIA**

In section 5, add at the end the following:

1 “(f) INTERNATIONAL BORDER TECHNOLOGY
2 PLAN.—Not later than 90 days after the date of enact-
3 ment of this Act, the Commissioner of United States Cus-
4 toms and Border Protection shall develop and submit to
5 the Committee on Homeland Security of the House of
6 Representatives and the Committee on Homeland Security
7 and Governmental Affairs of the Senate a comprehensive
8 plan for the deployment and use of technology for the se-
9 curity of the international borders of the United States.
10 Such plan shall include the following:

11 “(1) A description of existing technologies in
12 use along the international borders of the United
13 States.

14 “(2) Requirements relating to the compatibility
15 of new technologies with technologies referred to in
16 paragraph (1) that are in use as of the date of the
17 enactment of this Act.

1 “(3) A description of how the Commissioner
2 and the Commandant of the Coast Guard are work-
3 ing, or are expected to work, with the Under Sec-
4 retary for Science and Technology of the Depart-
5 ment of Homeland Security to identify and test new
6 technologies.

7 “(4) A description of the specific technologies
8 to be deployed along the international borders of the
9 United States.

10 “(5) Identification of any obstacles that may
11 impede the deployment described in paragraph (4).

12 “(6) A description on how the Commissioner
13 shall consult with border communities in the devel-
14 opment and deployment of technologies.

15 “(7) A description of how existing and proposed
16 technologies and infrastructure used for land and
17 maritime security will impact the environmental, so-
18 cial, economic, and cultural conditions of sur-
19 rounding communities.

20 “(8) A detailed estimate of all costs associated
21 with the deployment of new technologies and infra-
22 structure, and with continued maintenance of such
23 technologies and infrastructure.

1 “(9) A detailed estimate of personnel needed to
2 operate and maintain the technologies and infra-
3 structure described in paragraph (8).

4 “(10) A description of how the Commissioner is
5 working with the Administrator of the Federal Avia-
6 tion Administration on safety and airspace control
7 issues associated with the use of unmanned aerial
8 vehicles.

9 “(11) A description of technologies developed or
10 utilized by the Department of Defense, including any
11 such technologies determined to be excess by the
12 Secretary of Defense.

13 “(12) A description of how the Commissioner
14 will work with the Governments of Canada and Mex-
15 ico to develop a comprehensive technology plan to
16 streamline cross border technology coordination.”.
