Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Homeland Security3 for Children Act".

4 SEC. 2. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE UNDER SECRETARY FOR 5 STRATEGY, POLICY, AND PLANS.

Paragraph (6) of section 709(c) of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 349(c)) is amended by inserting ", including feedback from organizations representing
the needs of children," after "stakeholder feedback".

10 SEC. 3. TECHNICAL EXPERT AUTHORIZED.

Paragraph (2) of section 503(b) of the Homeland Security Act (6 U.S.C. 313(b)) is amended—

13 (1) in subparagraph (G), by striking "and" at14 the end;

15 (2) in subparagraph (H), by striking the period
16 at the end and inserting "; and"; and

17 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-18 paragraph:

1 "(I) identify and integrate the needs of 2 children into activities to prepare for, protect 3 against, respond to, recover from, and mitigate 4 against the risk of natural disasters, acts of ter-5 rorism, and other manmade disasters, including 6 catastrophic incidents, including by appointing 7 a technical expert, who may consult with rel-8 evant outside organizations and experts, as nec-9 essary, to coordinate such integration, as nec-10 essary.".

11 **SEC. 4. REPORT.**

12 Not later than one year after the date of the enact-13 ment of this Act and annually thereafter for five years, the Under Secretary for Strategy, Policy, and Plans of the 14 15 Department of Homeland Security shall submit to the Committee on Homeland Security of the House of Rep-16 resentatives and the Committee on Homeland Security 17 and Governmental Affairs of the Senate a report describ-18 ing the efforts the Department has undertaken to identify 19 20and integrate the needs of children into the Department's 21 policies, programs, and activities in accordance with para-22 graph (4) of section 709(c) of the Homeland Security Act 23 of 2002 (as added by section 2 of this Act), including in-24 formation on the following:
